#### Mission to Peru March 2022



The first week of this mission took place on the coast, in the provinces of Barranca and Huaura and the second in the department of Ayacucho.

On Sunday, March 6, the Peruvian team and I are in Limán to attend the inauguration of the solar pumped water project. The following days, we make many trips to meet with the drinking water committees of villages where projects have been or are in the process of being realized as well as future projects. Peruvian hospitality obliges, the communities always offer us a copious meal!

The mayors recognize and appreciate the work of *Wings of Hope* and ask us to intervene in their villages where they do not have the possibility to do so due to lack of funding or if pumping



is required. On the coast, we were received in the town halls of Supe, Santa Maria, Végueta and Supe Puerto; in the Andes, in the town halls of Vilcashuamán, Vischongo, Millpo, Luricocha and Uchuraccay.

On Sunday, March 13, the inauguration of the project of Colpapampa, also with solar pumping, takes place. As in Limán, the families express their gratitude for the support given to the realization of their water project.

#### Ginette Thibault Fund

Ginette Thibault, a physician and member of the *Wings* of *Hope Corporation*, passed away last May from cancer at the age of 73. Originally from the Côte-Nord, she had mainly practiced medicine in the Lachute area. Ginette Thibault was the wife of the late Claude Gagnon, ex-president of *Les Ailes de l'Espérance*, and had accompanied him on his missions to Peru, which gave her the opportunity to assist the medical staff in the Amazon. She had developed a special affection for the Peruvian people and our cause of access to water for remote communities in that country.

At the last revision of her will, Ginette Thibault decided to leave 10% of her estate to *Wings of Hope*. Her gesture shows that the will allows us to make a more important contribution than we thought.

On November 29, her sister Renée, the liquidator, came to personally present us with the bequest.

## Water for all

in Nueva Galilea



Nueva Galilea is a village located in the district of Raymundi, about two hours by boat to the North of Atalaya, on the right bank of the Ucayali River. The village has about 70 families (300 inhabitants) of the Ashaninka ethnic group. These families live from fishing and agriculture. There is an elementary school with about 60 students.

This village has no access to drinking water; people consume stagnant,

greenish water from a highly contaminated stream. In 2019, the provincial government built a tambo, multi-service



center. Access to drinking water was included in the project, but the dishonest contractor left only a 4 m hole from which no water comes out. The locals felt cheated. They contacted the *Alas de Esperanza* team.

The proposed project consists of digging a 12-15 m deep artisanal well, building a 15 m³ high tank, installing a solar pumping system and a distribution network to bring the water to the houses and three premises. Each family will have a cement sink.

A drinking water committee is in place and the community of Nueva Galilea agrees to provide all the unskilled labor necessary to complete the project.

The total cost of this project is \$113,492. However, 23% of the budget represents the labor contributed by the population and the materials also provided by the community. Outside assistance required is \$87,858. Thank you in advance for supporting the work of these indigenous people in their quest for a dignified life, which consistent access to clean water will provide.
